CAMPER CODE OF CONDUCT

At Trinity Hill Top Day Camp, we strive to provide a fun, safe and respectful environment for our campers. To assist us in offering the best camp experience, please review our camper code of conduct (below).

If problem behaviour is serious and persistent, and should the Camp Director, in consultation with the program staff, feel that a particular camper is a threat to any fellow camper, staff member or guest, he/she will be asked to leave the camp immediately. Parents or guardians will be notified and will be required to pick up your child. The first offence will result in the camper being sent home for the day; should a second offence occur; the camper will no longer be permitted at camp. Policies and procedures related to staff conduct are available to parent/guardians upon request.

Any camper that breaks any of the following rules will be sent home immediately. There will be no refund of camp fees.

- Smoking, alcohol and illicit drugs are strictly prohibited at Trinity Hill Top Day Camp
- Weapons or any implement that our staff deems dangerous or potentially dangerous are strictly prohibited

Any camper that breaks any of the following rules MAY be sent home based on the seriousness of the offence. There will be no refund of camp fees

- Inappropriate behaviour including: bullying, teasing, harassment, swearing, acts of aggression, pranks, practical jokes, offensive or insulting language towards others and self are not tolerated at Camp
- Ownership and use of cell phones by campers is only tolerated during specific programming times
- Stealing or borrowing others' possessions without asking their consent will not be tolerated
- Vandalizing or damage to camp property or Trinity property is a serious offence and will not be tolerated. Parents/guardians are responsible for the cost of the repair or replacement, including labour
